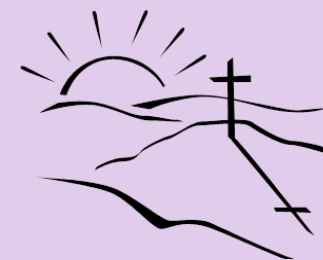

Ways God can use us and our gifts. May we be sensitive to the needs of those around us at this time.

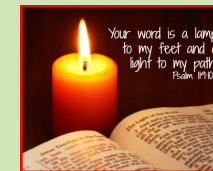
Your word is like a lamp, O Lord,
