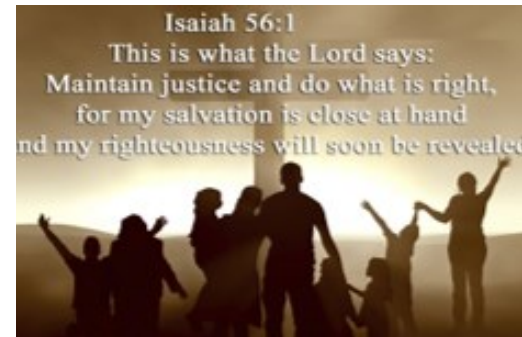

† **THOSE IN NEED AND OUR MINISTRIES**

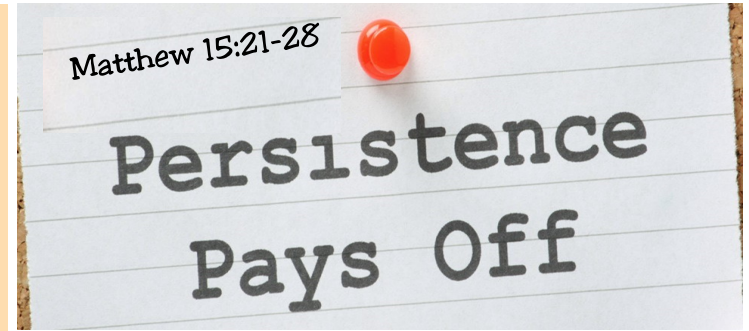
