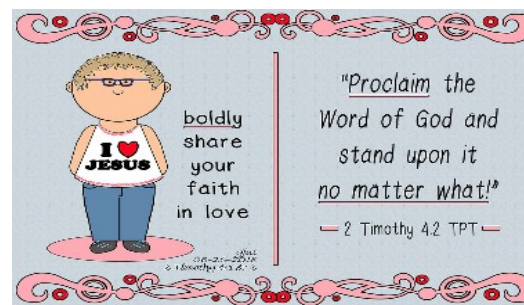

Elijah's Test

The Sunday school teacher was explaining the story of Elijah the Prophet and the false prophets of Baal to her class.
