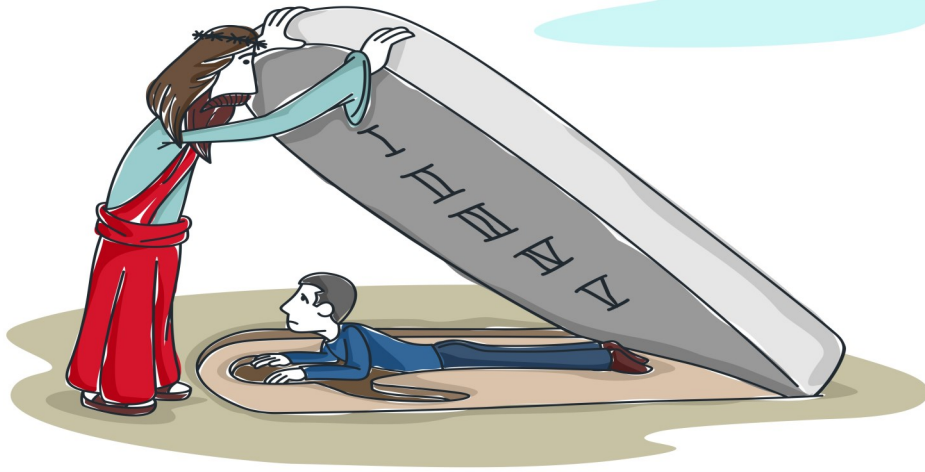

Dying for a Translation

Did you know that five to six hundred years ago, translating the Bible from Latin into a vernacular language could get a person into serious trouble? However John Wycliffe, a priest and a professor at Oxford University courageously recognised the right of ordinary Christians to be able to read and hear the scriptures in English. His English New Testament first became available in 1382. This was before the advent of the printing press, so the copies of Wycliffe's translation were all copied by hand! Forty three years after his death - as a punishment for his 'sin' - the Church had Wycliffe's body dug up, burned, and the ashes thrown into the river Swift. Another early translator, William Tyndale, was burnt at the stake for heresy in 1536. There are now approximately five hundred versions of the bible in English.

Let's thank God for those who were persecuted and martyred to give us God's Word in our own language.
