At Gore Baptist Church

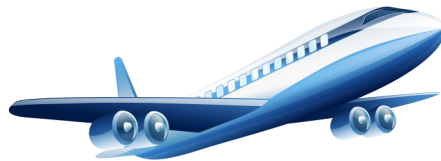
Sunday 13 August at 7pm.
