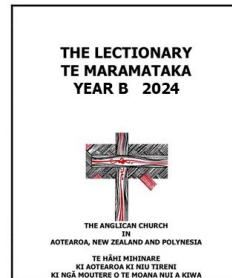
We have received Gloria's resignation as our Parish Administrator and we wish her and Stan best wishes for the future and a full recovery for Stan now that he has returned home.

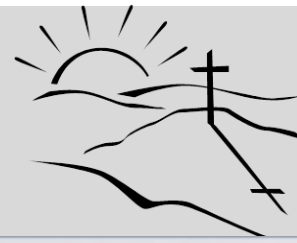
