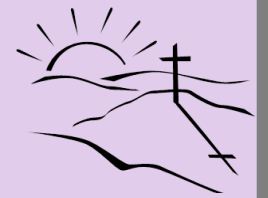

† **THE LOCAL COMMUNITY & THE COMMUNITY OF HEAVEN**

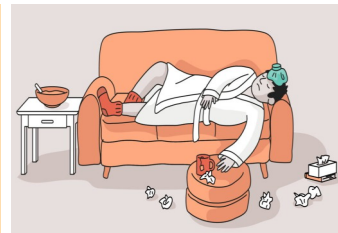
We pray for the farming community and the agencies that support them in our district.
